The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 105-277.1(a2) reads as rewritten:	
"(a2) Income Eligibility Limit. – Until July 1, 2003,2009, the income	
limit is eighteen twenty-five thousand dollars (\$18,000).(\$25,000). For tax	able years
beginning on or after July 1, 2003,2009, the income eligibility limit is the a	amount for
the preceding year, adjusted by the same percentage of this amount as the per	centage of
any cost-of-living adjustment made to the benefits under Titles II and XVI of	the Social
Security Act for the preceding calendar year, rounded to the nearest one hund	red dollars
(\$100.00). On or before July 1 of each year, the Department of Revenue must	determine
the income eligibility amount to be in effect for the taxable year beginning the	following
July 1 and must notify the assessor of each county of the amount to be in effective to be in effective.	ect for that
taxable year."	
SECTION 2. This act is effective for taxes imposed for tax	able years

beginning on or after July 1, 2008.
