2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE A COMMERCIAL DRIVERS LICENSE THAT HAS A
3 SCHOOL BUS ENDORSEMENT TO EXPIRE THREE YEARS AFTER IT IS
4 ISSUED.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-7(f)(2) reads as rewritten:

7 "(f) Duration and Renewal of Licenses. – Drivers licenses shall be issued and
8 renewed pursuant to the provisions of this subsection.

9 ...

10 (2) Duration of license for persons at least 18 years of age or older. – A
11 drivers license issued to a person at least 18 years old but less than 54
12 years old expires eight years after the date of issuance. A drivers
13 license issued to a person at least 54 years old expires five years after
14 the date of issuance. A commercial drivers license that has a vehicles
15 carrying passengers (P) and school bus (S) endorsement issued
16 pursuant to G.S. 20-37.16 shall expire on the birth date of the licensee
17 three years after the date of issuance, if the licensee is certified to drive
18 a school bus in North Carolina.

20 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
