2	AN ACT TO REQUIRE INVESTIGATIONS OF THE USE OF DEADLY FORCE BY
3	LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Article 8 of Chapter 147 of the General Statutes is amended by
6	adding a new section to read:
7	" <u>§ 147-90. Investigations of uses of deadly force.</u>
8	In every instance in which a private citizen is killed as a result of the use of a firearm
9	by a law enforcement officer in the line of duty, the district attorney in the prosecutorial
10	district in which the death occurred shall, upon the request of the surviving spouse or
11	next of kin of the private citizen within 180 days of the death, request the State Bureau
12	of Investigation to conduct an investigation into the incident. For purposes of this
13	section, the term "next of kin" includes only the child, father, mother, sister, or brother
14	of the private citizen.
15	Statements prepared by or on behalf of a district attorney pursuant to this section are
16	not public records as defined by G.S. 132-1 and may be released by the district attorney
17	only as provided by G.S. 132-1.4 or other applicable law."
18	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2007, and applies to acts

19 occurring on or after that date.
