5	SECT	TON 1. G.S. 14-269.4 reads as rewritten:	
6	"§ 14-269.4. W	eapons on State property and in courthouses.	
7	It shall be unlawful for any person to possess, or carry, whether openly or concealed,		
8	any deadly weapon, not used solely for instructional or officially sanctioned ceremonial		
9	purposes in the State Capitol Building, the Executive Mansion, the Western Residence		
10	of the Governor, or on the grounds of any of these buildings, and in any building		
11	housing any court of the General Court of Justice. If a court is housed in a building		
12	containing nonpublic uses in addition to the court, then this prohibition shall apply only		
13	to that portion of the building used for court purposes while the building is being used		
14	for court purposes.		
15	This section shall not apply to:
