2 AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE HOUSE SELECT  
3 COMMITTEE ON THE EDUCATION OF STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES TO  
4 CLARIFY THE DEFINITION OF RESIDENCE FOR THE DELIVERY OF  
5 SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-106.3 is amended by adding the following new  
8 subdivision to read:

9 "(18a) 'Residence' or 'reside' means the local educational agency in which the  
10 child with disabilities lives and is qualified for admission under  
11 G.S. 115C-366 except for the age requirements of that section. This  
12 definition shall not apply to children with disabilities who were  
13 enrolled in a particular local educational agency on the last day of  
14 school for the 2006-2007 school year for as long as they live within  
15 and are continuously enrolled in that local educational agency."

16 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
