2 AN ACT TO REPEAL A BUDGET PROVISION GRANTING IN-STATE TUITION  
3     TO CERTAIN FULL SCHOLARSHIP STUDENTS.  
4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
5             **SECTION 1.** G.S. 116-143.6 is repealed.  
6             **SECTION 2.** The repeal of G.S. 116-143.6 by Section 1 of this act does not  
7 affect the receipt of full scholarships for the 2006-2007 and 2007-2008 academic years  
8 by persons who received the scholarships prior to the repeal.  
9             **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
