**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding G.S. 143-64.80 or any other provision of law, the Department of Public Instruction shall not recoup State funds allocated in error to the Burke County School Administrative Unit or the Cleveland County School Administrative Unit to provide incentive funding for schools that met or exceeded the projected levels of improvement in student performance during the 2006-2007 school year, in accordance with the ABCs of Public Education Program.

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
