A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PER CHILD ALLOCATION FOR CHILDREN WITH
DISABILITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of seventeen million three hundred seventy-one thousand one hundred dollars (\$17,371,100) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to increase supplemental funding for children with disabilities to three thousand four hundred fifty dollars and eighty-one cents (\$3,450.81) per child.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
