## **SESSION LAW 2008-172 HOUSE BILL 2265**

AN ACT TO EXEMPT BUSES FROM SAFETY INSPECTIONS REQUIRED UNDER MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS IF THEY ARE TITLED TO A LOCAL BOARD OF EDUCATION AND SUBJECT TO SCHOOL BUS INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE TRANSPORTATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-183.2(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) Safety Inspection Exception. Exceptions. – Historic vehicles, as defined in G.S. 20-79.4(b)(55), The following vehicles shall not be subject to a safety inspection pursuant to this Article. Article:

Historic vehicles, as defined in G.S. 20-79.4(b)(55). <u>(1)</u>

 $\overline{(2)}$ Buses titled to a local board of education and subject to the school bus inspection requirements specified by the State Board of Education and G.S. 115C-248(a)."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
