The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. The following acts are repealed:	
(1) Chapter 257 of the 1973 Session Laws, as amended by C	Chapter 89 of
the 1977 Session Laws;	
(2) Chapter 1002 of the 1973 Session Laws;	
(3) Chapter 1154 of the 1979 Session Laws; and	
(4) Chapter 810 of the 1989 Session Laws.	
SECTION 2. It is unlawful to hunt with or discharge a firearm	on, from, or
across the right-of-way of any highway or public road.	
SECTION 3. It is unlawful to possess a loaded firearm outside t	the passenger
compartment of a vehicle while on the roadway or highway right-of-way	y, unless the
person is the owner or lessee of the land abutting the right-of-way or has o	on his person
the written permission of the owner or lessee of the land abutting the rig	ght-of-way to
hunt on the land, dated within the last 12 months.	
SECTION 4. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.	

SECTION 6. This act applies only to Martin County.

SECTION 7. This act becomes effective October 1, 2008, and applies to offenses occurring on or after that date.
