2	AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING FROM THE RIGHT-OF-WAY IN MARTIN
3	COUNTY.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The following acts are repealed:
6	(1) Chapter 257 of the 1973 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 89 of
7	the 1977 Session Laws;
8	(2) Chapter 1002 of the 1973 Session Laws;
9	(3) Chapter 1154 of the 1979 Session Laws; and
10	(4) Section 1 of Chapter 810 of the 1989 Session Laws.
11	<b>SECTION 2.</b> It is unlawful to hunt with or discharge a firearm on, from, or
12	across the right-of-way of any highway or public road.
13	<b>SECTION 3.</b> It is unlawful to possess a loaded firearm outside the passenger
14	compartment of a vehicle while on the roadway or highway right-of-way, unless the
15	person is the owner or lessee of the land abutting the right-of-way or has on his person
16	the written permission of the owner or lessee of the land abutting the right-of-way to
17	hunt on the land, dated within the last 12 months, or the person has a concealed carry
18	permit and is only carrying a loaded, concealed weapon.
19	<b>SECTION 4.</b> Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.
20	SECTION 5. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the
21	Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers
22	with general subject matter jurisdiction.
23	<b>SECTION 6.</b> This act applies only to Martin County.
24	SECTION 7. This act becomes effective October 1, 2008, and applies to
25	offenses occurring on or after that date.
