A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN APPURTENANCE TOLERANCE OF SIX INCHES FOR
3	RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND TO INCREASE THE ALLOWABLE
4	LENGTH OF A COMBINATION OF VEHICLES THAT INCLUDES A
5	RECREATIONAL VEHICLE FROM FIFTY-FIVE FEET TO SIXTY-FIVE FEET.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-116(a) reads as rewritten:
8	"§ 20-116. Size of vehicles and loads.
9	(a) The total outside width of any vehicle or the load thereon shall not exceed
10	102 inches, except as otherwise provided in this section. When hogsheads of tobacco
11	are being transported, a tolerance of six inches is allowed. When sheet or bale tobacco is
12	being transported the load must not exceed a width of 114 inches at the top of the load
13	and the bottom of the load at the truck bed must not exceed the width of 102 inches
14	inclusive of allowance for load shifting or settling. A tolerance of six inches on each
15	side is allowed for non-load bearing appurtenances, including awnings of recreational
16	vehicles. Vehicles (other than passenger buses) that do not exceed the overall width of
17	102 inches and otherwise provided in this section may be operated in accordance with
18	G.S. 20-115.1(c), (f), and (g).

20	SECTION 2. G.S. 20-116(b) reads as rewritten:
21	"
22	(b) No passenger-type vehicle or recreational vehicle shall be operated on any
23	highway with any load carried thereon extending beyond the line of the fenders on the
24	left side of such vehicle nor extending more than six inches beyond the line of the
25	fenders on the right side thereof.
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27	SECTION 3. G.S. 20-116(e) reads as rewritten:

Except as provided by G.S. 20-115.1, no combination of vehicles coupled 1 (e) 2 together shall consist of more than two units and no such combination of vehicles shall 3 exceed a total length of 60 feet inclusive of front and rear bumpers, subject to the 4 following exceptions: Said length limitation shall not apply to vehicles operated in the 5 daytime when transporting poles, pipe, machinery or other objects of a structural nature 6 which cannot readily be dismembered, nor to such vehicles transporting such objects 7 operated at nighttime by a public utility when required for emergency repair of public 8 service facilities or properties, but in respect to such night transportation every such 9 vehicle and the load thereon shall be equipped with a sufficient number of clearance 10 lamps on both sides and marker lamps upon the extreme ends of said projecting load to 11 clearly mark the dimensions of such load: Provided that vehicles designed and used 12 exclusively for the transportation of motor vehicles shall be permitted an overhang 13 tolerance front or rear not to exceed five feet. Provided, that wreckers may tow a truck, 14 combination tractor and trailer, trailer, or any other disabled vehicle or combination of 15 vehicles to a place for repair, parking, or storage within 50 miles of the point where the 16 vehicle was disabled and may tow a truck, tractor, or other replacement vehicle to the 17 site of the disabled vehicle. Provided, however, that a combination of a house trailer 18 used as a mobile home, together with its towing vehicle, shall not exceed a total length 19 of 55 feet exclusive of front and rear bumpers. Provided, however, that a combination of 20 two vehicles that includes a recreational vehicle shall not exceed a total length of 65 feet 21 exclusive of front and rear bumpers and mirrors. Provided further, that the said 22 limitation that no combination of vehicles coupled together shall consist of more than 23 two units shall not apply to trailers not exceeding three in number drawn by a motor 24 vehicle used by municipalities for the removal of domestic and commercial refuse and 25 street rubbish, but such combination of vehicles shall not exceed a total length of 50 feet 26 inclusive of front and rear bumpers. Provided further, that the said limitation that no 27 combination of vehicles coupled together shall consist of more than two units shall not 28 apply to a combination of vehicles coupled together by a saddle mount device used to 29 transport motor vehicles in a driveway service when no more than three saddle mounts 30 are used and provided further, that equipment used in said combination is approved by 31 the safety regulations of the Federal Highway Administration and the safety rules of the 32 Department of Crime Control and Public Safety."

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SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
