A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AUTHORIZING TWO CHARTER SCHOOLS TO MERGE AND  
OPERATE AS A SINGLE CHARTER SCHOOL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** The boards of directors of the American Renaissance Middle School and the American Renaissance Charter School may consolidate the schools into a single charter school under a joint board of directors with a grade configuration of kindergarten through eighth grade. All students enrolled in either school prior to the merger may remain in the newly consolidated school for the remainder of the 2006-2007 school year.

The newly consolidated school may continue to operate as a charter school pursuant to Part 6A of Article 16 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes under the charter of the American Renaissance Middle School.

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
