8	(3) (applicable to most localities) Is more than five years old and appears
9	to be worth less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00); [or]
10	(4) Is more than five years old and appears to be worth less than five
11	hundred dollars (\$500.00). This subdivision applies only to the Cities
12	of Belmont, Bessemer City, Cherryville, Gastonia and Mount Holly,
13	and the Towns of Ahoskie, Ayden, Cramerton, Dallas, Farmville,
14	LaGrange, Mint Hill, Louisburg and Stanley."
