10	<u>(1)</u>	Be aligned with the revised standards for the evaluation of school
11		executives and specifically address the use of the results of the Teacher
12		Working Conditions Survey:
13	<u>(2)</u>	Require evidence of a high level of institutional commitment,
14		including dedicated resources, for administrator preparation program
15		improvements and redesign;
16	<u>(3)</u>	Require the use of cross-functional work teams to determine a
17		common curriculum framework that (i) is designed to align with
18		defined standards, (ii) includes rigorous core courses, and (iii) will
19		produce administrators who meet the defined standards. The
20		cross-functional work teams shall include school-based personnel,
21		faculty from schools of education and other disciplines from
22		institutions of higher education, and representatives of State agencies;
23	<u>(4)</u>	Require the use of cross-functional work teams to design and
24		periodically update specific standards regarding placement, required
25		activities, and evaluations of clinical experiences. These standards
26		shall include appropriate training for the school leaders who agree to
27		accept and supervise interns;

1	<u>(5)</u>	Require written agreements between the institution of higher education
2		and a local school administrative unit to govern their shared
3		responsibility for (i) recruitment and preparation of school
4		administrators, especially with regard to clinical experiences including
5		the internship, and (ii) a new administrator's success once employed;
6	<u>(6)</u>	Require authentic partnerships between adjunct faculty and full-time
7		faculty to fully address the need for both practical, field-based
8		experience and academic, theory-based experience. These partnerships
9		may require a change in the institution of higher education's definition
10		of scholarly activity and its reward system;
11	<u>(7)</u>	Require all candidates to complete a year-long internship; and
12	<u>(8)</u>	Require the development of portfolios for emerging leaders that
13		provide evidence they are applying their training to actual school
14		needs and challenges.
