A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWN OF ORIENTAL TO EXERCISE
EXTRATERRITORIAL PLANNING JURISDICTION IN A DEFINED AREA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-360(k), as it applies to the Town of Oriental under
Section 3 of Chapter 478 of the 1977 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"(k) No town or city in Pamlico County having a population of 1,000 or less,
according to the most recent federal decennial census, shall exercise any extraterritorial
jurisdiction or powers outside its corporate limits pursuant to the provisions of this
~~Article.~~ Article, except this section does not apply to the Town of Oriental in the
following described area: north of North Street, east of Silverbrook Road, southeast of
Straight Road, southwest and northwest of White Farm Road, and northwest of Tarpon
Drive extending to Whittaker Creek, but not more than one mile from the corporate
limits."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
