A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PERMIT THE TAKING OF FOXES AND COYOTES BY TRAPPING
2 IN CUMBERLAND, HARNETT, AND MOORE COUNTIES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open
6 season for taking foxes and coyotes by trapping from October 1 through January 31 of
7 each year. This section applies only to Moore County.

8 **SECTION 1.1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open
9 season for taking foxes and coyotes by trapping from December 1 through January 31 of
10 each year. This section applies only to Cumberland and Harnett Counties.

11 **SECTION 2.** A season bag limit of 10 applies in the aggregate to all foxes
12 taken during the trapping season established in this act. No bag limit applies to coyotes
13 taken under this act.

14 **SECTION 3.** The Wildlife Resources Commission shall provide for the sale
15 of foxes taken lawfully pursuant to this act.

16 **SECTION 4.** This act applies only to Cumberland, Harnett, and Moore
17 Counties.

18 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2007, and expires on
19 September 30, 2010.
