2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
3 STUDY THE DEFINITION OF CHILD CARE AND THE POTENTIAL NEED TO
4 REGULATE AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** The Legislative Research Commission may study the
7 definition of child care as defined in G.S. 110-86, and the potential need to regulate
8 after-school programs. In conducting the study, the Commission shall consider whether
9 the definition of child care shall include after-school programs.

10 **SECTION 2.** The Legislative Research Commission shall make its findings
11 and recommendations in a final report to the 2008 Regular Session of the 2007 General
12 Assembly.

13 **SECTION 3.** From funds appropriated to the General Assembly, the
14 Legislative Services Commission shall allocate funds for the purpose of conducting the
15 study provided for in this act.

16 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
