A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ADD THE CITIES OF ALBEMARLE AND ROCKINGHAM AND THE TOWN OF OAKBORO TO AREAS LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES MAY USE ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES ON HIGHWAYS WITH POSTED SPEED LIMITS OF THIRTY-FIVE MILES PER HOUR OR LESS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 3 of S.L. 2004-108, as rewritten by S.L. 2005-305, S.L. 2006-25, and S.L. 2006-116, reads as rewritten:

**"SECTION 3.** Section 1 of this act applies to the ~~City of Albemarle and the Towns~~ of Beaufort, Highlands, Southern Shores, and Mint Hill only. Section 2 of this act applies to the Towns of Cramerton, Dallas, Duck, Kill Devil Hills, Kitty Hawk, Nags Head, Oakboro, Ocean Isle Beach, Surf City, and Stanley, the Cities of Albemarle, Belmont, Cherryville, Gastonia, Kings ~~Mountain and Mount Holly~~, Mountain, Mount Holly and Rockingham and the Counties of Cleveland, Currituck, Gaston, Surry, and Wilkes only. The term 'municipal employee' shall include employees of a county."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
