A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR ALLOCATION TO THE AREA AGENCIES ON AGING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services, the sum of nine hundred eighty-four thousand three hundred dollars (\$984,300) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of nine hundred eighty-four thousand three hundred dollars (\$984,300) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated in equal amounts to the 17 Area Agencies on Aging to ensure that there is adequate funding for services and planning activities, including funding for professional and administrative services to benefit senior citizens and to support and coordinate aging services and activities throughout the State.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
