A BILL TO BE ENTITLED APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO MANCHESTER CDC, INC., AN ACT TO HOLLYWOOD HEIGHTS COMMUNITY CLUB, INCORPORATED, SEVENTY **FIRST TOWNSHIP** CIVIC **IMPROVEMENT** ASSOCIATION. INCORPORATED, THE **TIFFANY PINES** COMMUNITY **OUTREACH** CENTER, AND THE SANDHILLS FAMILY HERITAGE ASSOCIATION TO SUPPORT COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Manchester CDC, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to develop cultural and recreational activities in the Manchester Township of Cumberland County.

**SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Hollywood Heights Community Club, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for community association improvements.

**SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Seventy First Township Civic Improvement Association, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to provide civic, cultural, and senior citizen activities.

**SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Tiffany Pines Community Outreach Center, a nonprofit organization, the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for use in providing bicycles and computers to disadvantaged youth in the City of Fayetteville and surrounding areas. The operator of this Center is known as the "Bicycle Man."

**SECTION 5.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Sandhills Family Heritage Association, a nonprofit organization, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to assist minority landowners living in

- 3 **SECTION 6.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
