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9 **SECTION 3.** If Section 5.3 of House Bill 36, 2007 Session, becomes law,  
10 there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Occupational and Environmental  
11 Epidemiology Branch of the Epidemiology Section of the Division of Public Health of  
12 the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of ninety-six thousand one  
13 hundred three dollars (\$96,103) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of forty-eight  
14 thousand fifty-two dollars (\$48,052) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to implement  
15 subsection (a) of Section 5.3 of House Bill 36, 2007 Session.

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21 **SECTION 4.** If Section 5.3(a) of House Bill 36, 2007 Session, becomes law,  
22 there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The  
23 University of North Carolina the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for  
24 the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be allocated to the North Carolina Institute for Disaster  
25 Studies (NCIDS), as authorized by Section 5.3(a) of House Bill 36, 2007 Session, to be  
26 used toward the costs of the following: (i) to assist in establishing NCIDS, a  
27 multidisciplinary, interinstitutional, basic and applied research program that applies  
28 state of the art concepts and technologies to address urgent and important disaster  
29 research questions, and (ii) to assist the campuses within The University of North  
30 Carolina to develop crisis management and crisis communications systems that will  
31 help individual campuses to better prepare in the event of a disaster.

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33 **APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE**  
34 **UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO STUDY THE EMISSION AND**  
35 **TRANSPORT OF POLLUTANTS AT FIRES AT COMMERCIAL**

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39 **SECTION 5.** If Section 5.3(b) of House Bill 36, 2007 Session, becomes law,  
40 there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The  
41 University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars  
42 (\$125,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:

- 43 (1) Seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) shall be used to study the  
44 emission and transport of pollutants at fires at commercial hazardous

1 waste facilities, as defined in G.S. 130A-295.01, which study is  
2 authorized by Section 5.3(b) of House Bill 36, 2007 Session; and  
3 (2) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to be used to research the human  
4 health and economic impacts of fires at commercial hazardous waste  
5 facilities, as defined in G.S. 130A-295.01, which research is  
6 authorized by Section 5.3(b) of House Bill 36, 2007 Session.
