A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT ANY PERSON APPLYING FOR A DUPLICATE
2 SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD, LEARNER'S PERMIT, OR DRIVERS
3 LICENSE THAT WAS ISSUED BY USING AN INDIVIDUAL TAXPAYER
4 IDENTIFICATION NUMBER BE REQUIRED TO PRODUCE A VALID SOCIAL
5 SECURITY NUMBER.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-7(b1) reads as rewritten:

9 **"§ 20-7. Issuance and renewal of drivers licenses.**

10 ...

11 (b1) Application. – To obtain an identification card, learners permit, or drivers
12 license from the Division, a person shall complete an application form provided by the
13 Division, present at least two forms of identification approved by the Commissioner, be
14 a resident of this State, and, except for an identification card, demonstrate his or her
15 physical and mental ability to drive safely a motor vehicle included in the class of
16 license for which the person has applied. At least one of the forms of identification shall
17 indicate the applicant's residence address. The Division may copy the identification
18 presented or hold it for a brief period of time to verify its authenticity. To obtain an
19 endorsement, a person shall demonstrate his or her physical and mental ability to drive
20 safely the type of motor vehicle for which the endorsement is required.

21 The application form shall request all of the following information, and it shall
22 contain the disclosures concerning the request for an applicant's social security number
23 required by section 7 of the federal Privacy Act of 1974, Pub. L. No. 93-579:

24 (1) The applicant's full name.

25 (2) The applicant's mailing address and residence address.

26 (3) A physical description of the applicant, including the applicant's sex,
27 height, eye color, and hair color.

28 (4) The applicant's date of birth.

1 (5) The applicant's valid social security number.

2 (6) The applicant's signature.

3 The Division shall not issue an original or duplicate identification card, learners
4 permit, or drivers license to an applicant who fails to provide the applicant's valid social
5 security number."

6 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2008.
