A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA RESEARCH  
CAMPUS AT KANNAPOLIS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.(a)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Community Colleges System Office the sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year for the Biotechnology Training Center at Rowan-Cabarrus Community College and the Greenhouse at the North Carolina Research Campus in Kannapolis. These funds shall be used for equipment, faculty and staff, building operations, and lease expenses.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
