25	SECTION 1.(c) The State Board of Education shall adopt criteria to			
26	determine and collect current work experience credit. All work experience as a teacher			
27	assistant in any public school within the State or in another state shall be used in			
28	determining total work experience credit. The State Board of Education shall determine			
29	the amount and to what degree other comparable work experience counts towards			
30	teacher assistant work experience credit.			
31	SECTION 1.(d) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules and			
32	regulations necessary to implement this act.
