A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT OF THREE HUNDRED
2 APPLICATIONS BEFORE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IS
3 AUTHORIZED TO PRODUCE THE GOLD STAR SPECIAL PLATE; TO
4 CHANGE THE RECIPIENT OF FUNDS FROM THE OMEGA PSI PHI SPECIAL
5 PLATE FROM THE UNITED NEGRO COLLEGE FUND, INC., TO THE
6 CAROLINA UPLIFT FOUNDATION, INC., TO BE USED FOR YOUTH
7 ACTIVITY AND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS; TO ELIMINATE THE
8 ADDITIONAL FEE AMOUNT FOR THE BREAST CANCER AWARENESS
9 PLATE; AND TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO
10 ISSUE THE FOLLOWING NEW SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES:
11 PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS, JUVENILE DIABETES RESEARCH,
12 BREAST CANCER EARLIER DETECTION, AND HOSPICE CARE; AND TO
13 ELIMINATE THE FEE FOR THE GOLD STAR SPECIAL PLATE.
14

15 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

16 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:

17 "(b) Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number
18 assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina,
19 which may be abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of
20 expiration. A plate issued for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and
21 weighing 26,001 pounds or more, must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is
22 a special registration plate authorized in G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a
23 trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The plate issued for vehicles licensed for
24 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word "weighted".

25 Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the
26 Division for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for
27 6,000 pounds or less shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have
28 the words "First in Flight" printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and

1 numerals. The background of the plate shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying
2 over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying slightly upward and to the right. The
3 following special registration plates do not have to be a "First in Flight" plate. The
4 design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be approved by the Division
5 and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification.

27 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

28 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration
29 plates:

30 ...

31 (15a) Breast Cancer Earlier Detection. – Issuable to the registered owner of a
32 motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear
33 the phrase "Friends for An Earlier Breast Cancer Test."

34 ...

35 (54) Gold Star Lapel Button. – Issuable to the recipient of the Gold Star
36 lapel button. The plate shall bear the emblem of the Gold Star lapel
37 button and the words "Gold Star". ~~The Division may not issue the plate~~
38 ~~authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300~~
39 ~~applications for the plate.~~

40 ...

41 (58a) Hospice Care. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
42 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase
43 "Hospice Care" and the letters "HC" on the right side of the plate.

44 ...

(61a) Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Juvenile Diabetes Research" and the "sneaker" logo of the nonprofit group Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation International, Inc.

 (100a) Prostate Cancer Awareness. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle. The plate shall bear the phrase "Prostate Cancer Awareness" and a representation of a blue ribbon. The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the plate before it may be developed.

...."

SECTION 3. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one registration plate to a recipient of a Legion of Valor award, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including additional Legion of Valor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War plates, are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

11 plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the
12 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust
13 Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation
14 Trust Fund, which is established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

5 **SECTION 5.(a)** G.S. 20-81.12(b14) reads as rewritten:

6 "(b14) Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Plates. – The Division must receive 300 or more
7 applications for an Omega Psi Phi Fraternity plate and receive any necessary licenses,
8 without charge, from Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Incorporated, before the plate may be
9 developed. The Division ~~shall~~ must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and
10 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity
11 plates to ~~the United Negro College Fund, Inc., through the Winston-Salem Area Office~~
12 ~~for the benefit of UNCF colleges in this State.~~ the Carolina Uplift Foundation, Inc., for
13 youth activity and scholarship programs."

14 **SECTION 5.(b)** This section becomes effective July 1, 2007, and applies to
15 fees transferred from the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account on or after
16 that date.

17 **SECTION 6.** G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding the following new
18 subsections to read:

19 "(b62) Hospice Care. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
20 Hospice Care plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer
21 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
22 from the sale of Hospice Care plates to The Carolinas Center for Hospice and End of
23 Life Care for its programs in support of hospice care in North Carolina.

24 (b63) Breast Cancer Earlier Detection. – The Division must receive 300 or more
25 applications for a Breast Cancer Earlier Detection plate before the plate may be
26 developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and
27 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Breast Cancer Earlier
28 Detection plates to the Friends for An Earlier Breast Cancer Test, Inc., to support
29 services to detect breast cancer earlier.

30 (b64) Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation. – The Division must receive 300 or
31 more applications for the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation plate before the plate
32 may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and
33 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Juvenile Diabetes Research
34 Foundation plates to the Triangle Eastern North Carolina Chapter of the Juvenile
35 Diabetes Research Foundation International, Inc., to provide funding for research to
36 cure diabetes. The Foundation must distribute the amount it receives to all Juvenile
37 Diabetes Research Foundation, Inc., chapters located in the State in equal shares."

38 **SECTION 7.(a)** G.S. 20-79.7(a), as enacted by Section 3 of this act, reads
39 as rewritten:

40 "(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one
41 registration plate to a recipient of a Legion of Valor award, a 100% disabled veteran,
42 and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including additional
43 Legion of Valor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War plates, are subject to

1 the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional
