A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO PRODUCE
FOURTEEN NEW SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina, which may be abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of expiration. A plate issued for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and weighing 26,001 pounds or more, must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is a special registration plate authorized in G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The plate issued for vehicles licensed for 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word "weighted".

Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the Division for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for 6,000 pounds or less shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have the words "First in Flight" printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and numerals. The background of the plate shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying slightly upward and to the right. The following special registration plates do not have to be a "First in Flight" plate. The design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be approved by the Division and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification.

24 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.4(b)(14a) is recodified as G.S. 20-79.4(b)(14d).

25 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

26 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration
27 plates:

29 (2b) Air Force Combat Action Medal Recipient. – Issuable to a recipient of
30 the Air Force Combat Action Medal. The plate shall bear the phrase
31 "Combat Action Medal" and a representation of the Air Force Combat
32 Action Medal. The Division must receive at least 300 applications for
33 the plate before it may be developed.

35 (10a) ARTS NC. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
36 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "ARTS
37 NC" with a multicolored design representative of art.

39 (14b) Boating Enthusiast. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
40 vehicle. The plate may bear the phrase "Boating Enthusiast" and a
41 picture representing the sport of boating. The Division must receive at
42 least 300 applications for the plate before it may be developed.

- 1 (28a) Combat Action Badge Recipient. – Issuable to a recipient of the
2 Combat Action Badge. The plate shall bear the phrase "Combat Action
3 Badge" and a representation of the Combat Action Badge. The
4 Division must receive at least 300 applications for the plate before it
5 may be developed.
- 6 (28b) Combat Action Ribbon Recipient. – Issuable to a recipient of the
7 Combat Action Ribbon. The plate shall bear the phrase "Combat
8 Action Ribbon" and a representation of the Combat Action Ribbon.
9 The Division must receive at least 300 applications for the plate before
10 it may be developed.
- 11 (29a) Combat Medical Badge Recipient. – Issuable to a recipient of the
12 Combat Medical Badge. The plate shall bear the phrase "Combat
13 Medical Badge" and a representation of the Combat Medical Badge.
14 The Division must receive at least 300 applications for the plate before
15 it may be developed.
- 16 ...
- 17 (34a) CureSearch. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
18 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase
19 "CureSearch" with a ribbon logo in colors representative of the
20 National Childhood Cancer Foundation.
- 21 (34b) Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden. – Issuable to the registered owner of a
22 motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear
23 the phrase "Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden," the Daniel Stowe
24 Botanical Garden Foundation, Inc., corporate logo, and a rendering of
25 a plant representative of the Foundation.

- 27 (56b) Home of American Golf. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
28 vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the
29 phrase "Home of American Golf" and a representation related to the
30 sport of golf.
- 31 ...
- 32 (59a) International Association of Administrative Professionals. – Issuable
33 to a member of the International Association of Administrative
34 Professionals. The plate shall bear the logo of the International
35 Association of Administrative Professionals and the words "N.C.
36 Division." The Division must receive at least 300 applications for the
37 plate before it may be developed.
- 38 ...
- 39 (96a) Piedmont Wildlife Center. – Issuable to the registered owner of a
40 motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate may bear
41 the phrase "Piedmont Wildlife Center" and a picture representing the
42 Piedmont Wildlife Center, Inc.
- 43 ...

(105a) Retired Piedmont Airlines Employee. – This plate is issuable to a retired Piedmont Airlines employee presenting to the Division, along with the application for the plate, a copy of the employee's letter of retirement. The plate shall bear the phrase "PA" and the Piedmont Speed Bird logo.

(124a) Support Soccer. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Support Soccer" with a soccer ball logo representative of the North Carolina Soccer Hall of Fame, Inc.

SECTION 4. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one registration plate to a recipient of a Legion of Valor award, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including additional Legion of Valor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War plates, are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

SECTION 5. G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, which is established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

34 "(b2) State Attraction Plates. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications
35 for a State attraction plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must
36 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account
37 derived from the sale of State attraction plates to the organizations named below in
38 proportion to the number of State attraction plates sold representing that organization:

39 (1) Bald Head Island Light House. – The revenue derived from the special
40 plate shall be transferred quarterly to the Old Baldy Foundation, Inc.,
41 for its programs in support of the Bald Head Island Lighthouse.

42 (4)(3) Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation. – The revenue derived from the
43 special plate shall be transferred quarterly to Blue Ridge Parkway
44 Foundation for use in promoting and preserving the Blue Ridge

1 Parkway as a scenic attraction in North Carolina. A person may obtain
2 from the Division a special registration plate under this subdivision for
3 the registered owner of a motor vehicle or a motorcycle. The
4 registration fees and the restrictions on the issuance of a specialized
5 registration plate for a motorcycle are the same as for any motor
6 vehicle. The Division must receive a minimum of 300 applications to
7 develop a special registration plate for a motorcycle.

19 trailway and viewshed easement acquisitions, capital improvements
20 for the portions of the Appalachian Trail and connecting trails that are
21 located in North Carolina, and related administrative and operating
22 expenses.

23 (7) Friends of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. – The revenue
24 derived from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the
25 Friends of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Inc., to be used
26 for educational materials, preservation programs, capital
27 improvements for the portion of the Great Smoky Mountains National
28 Park that is located in North Carolina, and operating expenses of the
29 Great Smoky Mountains National Park.

30 ~~(1i)~~(9) North Carolina State Parks. – One-half of the revenue derived from the
31 special plate shall be transferred quarterly to Natural Heritage Trust
32 Fund established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the remaining revenue shall
33 be transferred quarterly to the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund
34 established under G.S. 113-44.15.

35 ~~(1j)~~(10) The North Carolina Aquariums. – The revenue derived from the
36 special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the North Carolina
37 Aquarium Society, Inc., for its programs in support of the North
38 Carolina Aquariums.

39 ~~(1m)~~(13) The North Carolina Arboretum. – The revenue derived from the
40 special plate shall be transferred quarterly to The North Carolina
41 Arboretum Society and used to help the Society obtain grants for the
42 North Carolina Arboretum and for capital improvements to the North
43 Carolina Arboretum.

1 ~~(1p)~~(17) The North Carolina Maritime Museum. – The revenue derived
2 from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to Friends of the
3 Museum, North Carolina Maritime Museum, Inc., to be used for
4 educational programs and conservation programs and for operating
5 expenses of the North Carolina Maritime Museum.

6 ~~(1t)~~(19) The North Carolina Museum of Natural Sciences. – The revenue
7 derived from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to the
8 Friends of the North Carolina State Museum of Natural Sciences for its
9 programs in support of the museum.

10 ~~(2)~~(25) The North Carolina Zoological Society. – The revenue derived
11 from the special plate shall be transferred quarterly to The North
12 Carolina Zoological Society, Incorporated, to be used for educational
13 programs and conservation programs at the North Carolina Zoo at
14 Asheboro and for operating expenses of the North Carolina Zoo at
15 Asheboro."

16 **SECTION 7.** G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding the following new
17 subsections to read:

18 "(b73) ARTS NC. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
19 ARTS NC plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer
20 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
21 from the sale of ARTS NC plates to ARTS North Carolina, Inc., to provide funding to
22 promote the arts in North Carolina.

23 (b74) Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden. – The Division must receive 300 or more
24 applications for the Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden plate before the plate may be
25 developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and
26 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Daniel Stowe Botanical
27 Garden plates to the Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden Foundation, Inc., to provide
28 funding for the Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden outreach program.

29 (b75) Home of American Golf. – The Division must receive 300 or more
30 applications for the Home of American Golf plate before the plate may be developed.
31 The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction
32 Plate Account derived from the sale of Home of American Golf plates to the Given
33 Memorial Library, Inc., to provide funding for the Given Memorial Library – The Tufts
34 Archives.

35 (b76) CureSearch. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
36 CureSearch plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer
37 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
38 from the sale of CureSearch plates to the National Childhood Cancer Foundation to
39 provide funding for pediatric cancer research in North Carolina.

40 (b77) Piedmont Wildlife Center. – The Division must receive 300 or more
41 applications for the Piedmont Wildlife Center plate before the plate may be developed.
42 The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction
43 Plate Account derived from the sale of Piedmont Wildlife Center plates to Piedmont

1 Wildlife Center, Inc., to support the conservation of North American wildlife and its
2 habitat in North Carolina through rehabilitation, education, and scientific study.

3 (b78) Retired Piedmont Airlines Employee. – The Division must receive 300 or
4 more applications for the Retired Piedmont Airlines Employee plate before the plate
5 may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and
6 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Retired Piedmont Airlines
7 Employee plates to Piedmont Silver Eagles Charitable Funds, Inc., to be used for
8 scholarships and family assistance for retired Piedmont Airlines employees and their
9 families, including surviving spouses and dependents, suffering economic hardship.

10 (b79) Support Soccer. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the
11 Support Soccer plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer
12 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived
13 from the sale of Support Soccer plates to the North Carolina Soccer Hall of Fame, Inc.,
14 to provide funding to promote the sport of soccer in North Carolina."

15 **SECTION 8.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
