5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of
7	Medical Assistance, shall adopt and implement a policy that will prevent a Medicaid
8	recipient from losing Medicaid eligibility when the annual Social Security and Railroad
9	Retirement Cost of Living Adjustments (COLAs) and the annual Federal Poverty Level
10	adjustment cause a Medicaid recipient to become income-ineligible for Medicaid. The
11	policy shall apply only in cases where Medicaid income eligibility is affected only by
12	Social Security and Railroad Retirement COLAs and Federal Poverty Level adjustments
13	and shall not render a Medicaid recipient eligible if all other eligibility requirements are
14	not met. If approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) is
15	required for this policy to be implemented, the Department shall apply to CMS for
16	approval.
17	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
