Short Title: Leland Annex DOT Right-of-Way. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWN OF LELAND TO ANNEX CERTAIN
RIGHTS-OF-WAY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Town of Leland may annex by ordinance any area of
Department of Transportation right-of-way bordered by the town as of May 15, 2008.

SECTION 2. The two areas authorized for annexation by Section 1 of this
act are more particularly described as follows:

(1) US 17 ROW segment 1: From a point approximately 477 feet NE of
Old Waterford Way SW to a point approximately 180 feet SW of
Ploof Road, a total distance of approximately 2,070 feet.

(2) US 17 ROW segment 2: From a point approximately 563 feet SW of
Ploof Road SW to the Leland town limits, a total distance of
approximately 2,628 feet.

SECTION 3. Any ordinance adopted under Section 1 of this act shall be
recorded under either G.S. 160A-39 or G.S. 160A-51, as appropriate, but the annexation
shall not otherwise be considered to have been adopted under Article 4A of Chapter
160A of the General Statutes.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
