

1 North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University, North Carolina Central
2 University, North Carolina School of the Arts, redesignated effective July 1, 2008, as
3 the 'University of North Carolina School of the Arts,' Pembroke State University,
4 redesignated effective July 1, 1996, as the "University of North Carolina at Pembroke",
5 Western Carolina University and Winston-Salem State University, and the constituent
6 high school, the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics."

7 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 116-5(a)(2) reads as rewritten:

8 "(2) One person elected prior to January 1, 1972, by and from the
9 membership of the board of trustees of each of the following
10 institutions: Elizabeth City State University, Fayetteville State
11 University, North Carolina School of the Arts, redesignated effective
12 July 1, 2008, as the 'University of North Carolina School of the Arts,'
13 Pembroke State University, redesignated effective July 1, 1996, as the
14 "University of North Carolina at Pembroke", and Winston-Salem State
15 University."

16 **SECTION 4.** G.S. 116-12 reads as rewritten:

17 **"§ 116-12. Property and obligations.**

18 All property of whatsoever kind and all rights and privileges held by the Board of
19 Higher Education and by the Boards of Trustees of Appalachian State University, East
20 Carolina University, Elizabeth City State University, Fayetteville State University,
21 North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University, North Carolina Central
22 University, North Carolina School of the Arts, redesignated effective July 1, 2008, as
23 the 'University of North Carolina School of the Arts,' Pembroke State University,
24 redesignated effective July 1, 1996, as the "University of North Carolina at Pembroke",
25 Western Carolina University and Winston-Salem State University, as said property,
26 rights and privileges may exist immediately prior to July 1, 1972, shall be, and hereby
27 are, effective July 1, 1972, transferred to and vested in the Board of Governors of the
28 University of North Carolina. All obligations of whatsoever kind of the Board of Higher
29 Education and of the Boards of Trustees of Appalachian State University, East Carolina
30 University, Elizabeth City State University, Fayetteville State University, North
31 Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University, North Carolina Central
32 University, North Carolina School of the Arts, redesignated effective July 1, 2008, as
33 the 'University of North Carolina School of the Arts,' Pembroke State University,
34 redesignated effective July 1, 1996, as the "University of North Carolina at Pembroke",
35 Western Carolina University and Winston-Salem State University, as said obligations
36 may exist immediately prior to July 1, 1972, shall be, and the same hereby are, effective
37 July 1, 1972, transferred to and assumed by the Board of Governors of the University of
38 North Carolina. Any property, real or personal, held immediately prior to July 1, 1972,
39 by a board of trustees of a constituent institution for the benefit of that institution or by
40 the University of North Carolina for the benefit of any one or more of its six
41 institutions, shall from and after July 1, 1972, be kept separate and distinct from other
42 property held by the Board of Governors, shall continue to be held for the benefit of the
43 institution or institutions that were previously the beneficiaries and shall continue to be
44 held subject to the provisions of the respective instruments, grants or other means or

1 process by which any property right was acquired. All property of whatsoever kind and
2 all rights and privileges held by the Board of Trustees of the North Carolina School of
3 Science and Mathematics, as said property, rights and privileges may exist immediately
4 prior to July 1, 2007, shall be and hereby are, effective July 1, 2007, transferred to and
5 vested in the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina. All obligations
6 of whatsoever kind of the Board of Trustees of the North Carolina School of Science
7 and Mathematics as said obligations may exist immediately prior to July 1, 2007, shall
8 be, and the same hereby are, effective July 1, 2007, transferred to and assumed by the
9 Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina. In case a conflict arises as to
10 which property, rights or privileges were held for the beneficial interest of a particular
11 institution, or as to the extent to which such property, rights or privileges were so held,
12 the Board of Governors shall determine the issue, and the determination of the Board
13 shall constitute final administrative action. Nothing in this Article shall be deemed to
14 increase or diminish the income, other revenue or specific property which is pledged, or
15 otherwise hypothecated, for the security or liquidation of any obligations, it being the
16 intent that the Board of Governors shall assume said obligations without thereby either
17 enlarging or diminishing the rights of the holders thereof."

18 **SECTION 5.** G.S. 116-31(a) reads as rewritten:

19 "(a) All persons who, as of June 30, 1972, are serving as trustees of the regional
20 universities and of the North Carolina School of the Arts, redesignated effective July 1,
21 2008, as the 'University of North Carolina School of the Arts,' except those who may
22 have been elected to the Board of Governors, shall continue to serve for one year
23 beginning July 1, 1972, and the terms of all such trustees shall continue for the period of
24 one year."

25 **SECTION 6.** G.S. 116-41.13A reads as rewritten:

26 **"§ 116-41.13A. Distinguished Professors Endowment Trust Fund; definitions.**

27 The following definitions apply in this Part:

- 28 (1) "Focused growth institution" means Elizabeth City State University,
29 Fayetteville State University, North Carolina Agricultural and
30 Technical University, North Carolina Central University, The
31 University of North Carolina at Pembroke, Western Carolina
32 University, and Winston-Salem State University.
33 (2) "Special needs institution" means the North Carolina School of the
34 Arts-Arts, redesignated effective July 1, 2008, as the 'University of
35 North Carolina School of the Arts' and The University of North
36 Carolina at Asheville."

37 **SECTION 7.** G.S. 116-64 reads as rewritten:

38 **"§ 116-64. Establishment of school.**

39 There is hereby established, and there shall be maintained, a school for the
40 professional training of students having exceptional talent in the performing arts which
41 shall be defined as an educational institution of the State, to serve the students of North
42 Carolina and other states, particularly other states of the South. The school shall be
43 designated the "North Carolina School of the Arts-Arts, redesignated effective July 1,
44 2008, as the 'University of North Carolina School of the Arts.'"

1 **SECTION 8.** G.S. 116-65 reads as rewritten:

2 "**§ 116-65. To be part of University of North Carolina; membership of Board of**
3 **Trustees.**

4 The North Carolina School of ~~Arts~~ Arts, redesignated effective July 1, 2008, as the
5 'University of North Carolina School of the Arts.' is a part of the University of North
6 Carolina and subject to the provisions of Article 1, Chapter 116, of the General Statutes;
7 provided, however, that notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 116-31, the Board of
8 Trustees of said school shall consist of 15 persons, 13 of whom are selected in
9 accordance with provisions of G.S. 116-31, and the conductor of the North Carolina
10 Symphony, or the conductor's designee, and the Secretary of the Department of Cultural
11 Resources, both serving ex officio and nonvoting."

12 **SECTION 9.** G.S. 116-209.19 reads as rewritten:

13 "**§ 116-209.19. Grants to students.**

14 The Authority is authorized to make grants to eligible students enrolled or to be
15 enrolled in eligible institutions in North Carolina out of such money as from time to
16 time may be appropriated by the State or as may otherwise be available to the Authority
17 for such grants. The Authority, subject to the provisions of this Article and any
18 applicable appropriation act, shall adopt rules, regulations and procedures for
19 determining the needs of the respective students for grants and for the purpose of
20 making such grants. The amount of any grant made by the Authority to any student,
21 whether enrolled or to be enrolled in any private institution or any tax-supported public
22 institution, shall be determined by the Authority upon the basis of substantially similar
23 standards and guides that shall be set forth in the Authority's rules, regulations and
24 procedures; provided, however, that grants made in any fiscal year to students enrolled
25 or to be enrolled in private institutions may be increased to compensate, in whole or in
26 part, for the average annual State appropriated tuition subsidy for such fiscal year,
27 determined as provided herein. The average annual State appropriated subsidy for each
28 fiscal year shall be determined by the Secretary of Administration, after consultation
29 with the Board of Governors of the University of North Carolina and the Authority, for
30 each of the two categories of tax-supported institutions, being (i) institutions, presently
31 16, that provide education of the collegiate grade and grant baccalaureate degrees and
32 (ii) institutions, such as community colleges and technical institutes created and existing
33 under Chapter 115A of the General Statutes and community colleges created and
34 existing under Chapter 115D of the General Statutes. The average annual State
35 appropriated subsidy for each of such two categories of institutions shall mean the
36 amount of the total appropriations of the State for the respective fiscal years under the
37 current operations budgets, pursuant to the State Budget Act reasonably allocable to
38 undergraduate students enrolled in such institutions exclusive of the Division of Health
39 Affairs of the University of North Carolina and the North Carolina School of the ~~Arts~~
40 Arts, redesignated effective July 1, 2008, as the 'University of North Carolina School of
41 the Arts' for all institutions in such category, all as shall be determined by the Secretary
42 of Administration after consultation as above provided, divided by the budgeted number
43 of North Carolina undergraduate students to be enrolled in such fiscal year.

1 The Authority, in determining the needs of students for grants, may among other
 2 factors, give consideration to the amount of other financial assistance that may be
 3 available to the students, such as nonrepayable awards under the Pell Grant Program,
 4 the Health Professions Education Assistance Act or other student assistance programs
 5 created by federal law."

6 **SECTION 10.** G.S. 147-54 reads as rewritten:

7 **"§ 147-54. Printing, distribution and sale of the North Carolina Manual.**

8 The Secretary of State shall have printed biennially for distribution and sale, two
 9 thousand three hundred fifty (2,350) copies of the North Carolina Manual, and shall
 10 make distribution to the State agencies, individuals, institutions and others as herein set
 11 forth.

33	institutions not covered in the above distribution shall be entitled to a twenty percent	
34	(20%) discount on the cost of any purchase(s)."	
35	SECTION 11. G.S. 165-20(6) reads as rewritten:	
36	"(6) "State educational institution" means any educational institution of	
37	higher learning which is owned and operated by the State of North	
38	Carolina, or any community college operated under the provisions of	
39	Chapter 115A and Article 3 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes of	
40	North Carolina, or the college program of the North Carolina School	
41	of the Arts, <u>redesignated effective July 1, 2008, as the 'University of</u>	
42	<u>North Carolina School of the Arts,'</u> or any technical institute operated	
43	under the provisions of Chapter 115A of the General Statutes of North	
44	Carolina."	

1 **SECTION 12.** The General Statutes are further amended by substituting the
2 phrase "University of North Carolina School of the Arts" for the phrase "North Carolina
3 School of the Arts" wherever that phrase may appear.

4 **SECTION 13.(a)** All statutory and other legal authority, powers, duties,
5 functions, records, personnel, property, and unexpended balances of appropriations or
6 other funds of the North Carolina School of the Arts remain those of the University of
7 North Carolina School of the Arts.

8 **SECTION 13.(b)** Nothing in this act requires the immediate replacement of
9 any stationery, other supplies, or any emblems or other symbols used by the University
10 of North Carolina School of the Arts, as they existed prior to the enactment of this act.
11 The University of North Carolina School of the Arts shall use funds within its budget to
12 replace these items, as necessary.

13 **SECTION 15.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
