**SESSION LAW 2008-61
SENATE BILL 2137**

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE TOWN OF SUMMERFIELD SHALL FOLLOW
THE GENERAL LAW FOR THE FILLING OF TOWN COUNCIL VACANCIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 3.4 of the Charter of the Town of Summerfield, being Chapter 426 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 3.4. **Vacancies.** ~~Notwithstanding G.S. 160A-63, persons appointed by the Town Council to fill vacancies~~ Vacancies on the Council serve the remainder of the unexpired term. shall be filled in accordance with G.S. 160A-63."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 7th day of July, 2008.
