**SENATE BILL 2138
RATIFIED BILL**

AN ACT TO REPEAL AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF
STONEVILLE PROVIDING FOR FOUR-YEAR TERMS FOR THE MAYOR
AND MEMBERS OF THE TOWN COUNCIL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. S.L. 1998-107 is repealed.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
