2	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY OF NEW HANOVER AND THE CITY	
3	OF WILMINGTON TO GIVE ANNUAL NOTICE TO CHRONIC VIOLATORS	
4	OF THE CITY'S PUBLIC NUISANCE ORDINANCE.	
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
6	SECTION 1. Section 1 of S.L. 2005-44 reads as rewritten:	
7	"SECTION 1. A municipality may notify a chronic violator of the municipality's	
8	public nuisance ordinance that, if the violator's property is found to be in violation of	
9	the ordinance, the municipality shall, without further notice in the calendar year in	
10	which notice is given, take action to remedy the violation, and the expense of the action	
11	shall become a lien upon the property and shall be collected as unpaid taxes. The initial	
12	annual notice shall be served by registered or certified mail. A chronic violator is a	
13	person who owns property whereupon, in the previous calendar year, the municipality	
14	gave notice of violation at least three times under any provision of the public nuisance	
15	ordinance. The term "municipality" means a city or a county."	
16	SECTION 2. Section 2 of S.L. 2005-44, as amended by Section 1 of S.L.	
17	2007-3, reads as rewritten:	
18	"SECTION 2. This act applies to the County of New Hanover, the City of	
19	Wilmington, and the Towns of Cornelius, Davidson, and Matthews only."	
20	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
