1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO COMPLETE THE APPLIED
3	TECHNOLOGY BUILDING ON THE TRANSYLVANIA CAMPUS OF BLUE
4	RIDGE COMMUNITY COLLEGE.
5	Whereas, plans have been made to construct the Applied Technology
6	Building on the Transylvania County campus of Blue Ridge Community College to
7	house nursing and mechanic programs and a small business incubator; and
8	Whereas, the facility will enable area residents to take courses in
9	Transylvania County rather than travel as much as one and one-half hours to take
10	similar courses in other counties; and
11	Whereas, this facility will provide Transylvania County employers with the
12	opportunity to hire locally trained workers in these vocations; and
13	Whereas, the Applied Technology Building will cost \$2,390,349, of which
14	Transylvania County has committed \$1,247,738, State bonds have produced \$664,869,
15	and a CDBG Grant has generated \$375,000; and
16	Whereas, additional funds are needed to begin construction of this facility;
17	Now, therefore,
18	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
19	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
20	Community Colleges System Office the sum of one hundred three thousand dollars
21	(\$103,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to complete the Applied Technology Building
22	on the Transylvania County campus of Blue Ridge Community College.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007. 23
