SENATE BILL 631

Short Title: Asheville/Woodfin Annexation Boundary. (Local)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ANNEX TO THE CITY OF ASHEVILLE OR TO THE TOWN OF
WOODFIN CERTAIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY SURROUNDED BY THE
CORPORATE LIMITS OF ASHEVILLE AND WOODFIN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Certain properties are surrounded by the corporate limits of the City of Asheville and the Town of Woodfin. These properties cannot be accessed without going through either Asheville or Woodfin, causing difficulties in providing governmental services. Some of these properties may be owned by the State or by the State through the University of North Carolina at Asheville. If an agreement can be reached agreeable to the parties involved, the properties may be considered for annexation to the City of Asheville or the Town of Woodfin.

SECTION 2. The corporate limits of the City of Asheville may be extended to include the following described property:

SECTION 3. The corporate limits of the Town of Woodfin may be extended to include the following described property:

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective June 30, 2007.
