10	violation occurs, violation of this section shall be a Class H felony.

12	(8) Driving with a child under <u>12-16 years</u> of age in the vehicle."	
13	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2007, and applies to	
14	offenses committed on or after that date.
