A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE GREENSBORO SYMPHONY SOCIETY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Greensboro Symphony Society, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to support the orchestra's Annual Gospel Concert and Education Programs, which serve more than 50,000 children in Alamance, Guilford, Randolph, and Rockingham Counties.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
