2 AN ACT TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR THE STUDY OF A TRANSPORTATION  
3 CORRIDOR IN NORTHEAST CHATHAM AND SOUTHWEST DURHAM  
4 COUNTIES IN THE FARRINGTON ROAD, FARRINGTON MILL ROAD, AND  
5 STAGECOACH ROAD AREAS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7       **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
8 Department of Transportation the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to study the  
9 feasibility of a transportation corridor in northeast Chatham and southwest Durham  
10 Counties in the Farrington Road, Farrington Mill Road, and Stagecoach Road areas to  
11 determine issues related to congestion, traffic flow, and safety. The Durham-Chapel  
12 Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization shall be responsible for contracting  
13 the study, and the study shall be paid for out of the funds appropriated to the  
14 Department of Transportation for this purpose.

15       **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
