Short Title: Extend Louisburg and Onslow Exemptions. (Local) Sponsors: Referred to: March 17, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO EXTEND THE EXEMPTION FOR THE TOWN OF LOUISBURG FROM THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE LOUISBURG ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND TO EXTEND THE APPLICATION OF THE 2006 BUILDING CODE FOR AN ONSLOW PROJECT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Section 4 of S.L. 2007-216 reads as rewritten: "SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law. Section 3 of this act shall expire January 1, 2009.2011." **SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any expiration dates to the contrary, there shall be an extension for the Onslow County Administrative Complex to permit under the 2006 North Carolina State Building Codes (Building, Energy Conservation, Fire, Fuel Gas, Mechanical, and Plumbing) until August 1, 2009, at which time the applicable Code shall apply.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
