4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 130A-309.10(f) reads as rewritten:
6	"(f) No person shall knowingly dispose of the following solid wastes in landfills:
7	
8	(11) Recyclable rigid plastic containers that are required to be labeled as provided
9	in subsection (e) of this section, that have a neck smaller than the body of the
10	container, and that accept a screw top, snap cap, or other closure. The
11	prohibition on disposal of recyclable rigid plastic containers in landfills does
12	not apply to rigid plastic containers that are intended for use in the sale or
13	distribution of motor oil.oil or pesticides.

15	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
