actual service shall be determined as provided in subsection (1) of this section. Upon the death 1 2 of a member in service, the surviving spouse may make all purchases for creditable service as 3 provided for under this Chapter for which the member had made application in writing prior to 4 the date of death, provided that the date of death occurred prior to or within 60 days after 5 notification of the cost to make the purchase. The term "in service" as used in this subsection includes a member in receipt of a benefit under the Disability Income Plan as provided in 6 7 Article 6 of this Chapter.

8 Notwithstanding the foregoing, a member who is in receipt of Workers' Compensation 9 during the period for which the member would have otherwise been eligible to receive 10 short-term benefits, as provided in G.S. 135-105, and who dies on or after 181 days from the 11 last day of the member's actual service but on or before the date the benefits as provided in 12 G.S. 135-105 would have ended, shall be considered in service at the time of the member's 13 death for the purpose of this benefit."

SECTION 2. G.S. 128-27(m) reads as rewritten:

Survivor's Alternate Benefit. – Upon the death of a member in service, the principal 15 "(m) beneficiary designated to receive a return of accumulated contributions shall have the right to 16 17 elect to receive in lieu thereof the reduced retirement allowance provided by Option two of 18 subsection (g) above computed by assuming that the member had retired on the first day of the 19 month following the date of his death, provided that all three of the following conditions apply:

46 SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law, and applies to 47 beneficiaries of law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty on and after January 1, 2007.
