The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Unless a person owns or possesses a leasehold interest in the real		
property immediately adjacent to the portion of the road on which the person is located, it is		
unlawful for that person to discharge a firearm from, on, or across the right-of-way of State		
Secondary Road 1862, known as Joyner Drive, from Adams Creek Road to the end of the		
State-maintained portion of the road.		
SE	ECTION 2. Violation of this act is a Class 3 m	nisdemeanor.
SE	ECTION 3. This act is enforceable by law e	nforcement officers of the Wildlife
Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers with general		
subject matter jurisdiction.
