5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 160A-48, a municipality to 7 which that section applies may adopt ordinances annexing property completely enclosed on 8 May 1, 2010, by the corporate limits of the municipality, if the ordinance makes a finding that 9 the total acreage being annexed is less than five percent (5%) of the total acreage within the 10 corporate limits of the municipality prior to the annexation and also either:

- 11 (1) Makes a finding based upon circumstances and evidence satisfactory to the municipality that the annexation is necessary for the orderly growth and development of the municipality; or
  14 (2) Makes a finding based upon circumstances and evidence satisfactory to the
  - (2) Makes a finding based upon circumstances and evidence satisfactory to the municipality that the annexation improves the ability to provide public safety services.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** The municipality shall fix a date for a public hearing on the 18 annexation and publish notice of the public hearing at least 10 days before the day of the 19 hearing.
- 20 **SECTION 3.** The procedure for recording any annexation under this act is as 21 provided in G.S. 160A-51.
- SECTION 4. Any annexation ordinance adopted under this act shall be adopted
  before December 31, 2020.
- 24 **SECTION 5.** This act applies only to the City of Kannapolis.
- 25 **SECTION 6.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
