7	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Section 84.1 of the Charter of the City of Durham, being Chapter 671	
8	of the 1975 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 474 of the 1983 Session Laws, reads as	
9	rewritten:	
10	"Sec. 84.1. Minority or Women's Business Enterprise Requirements. (a) The City	
11	Council may establish, agree to and/or comply with minimum minority and/or women's	
12	business enterprise participation requirements in projects financed by public funds to ensure	
13	equal employment opportunities and/or to redress past discrimination, by including such	
14	minimum requirements in the specifications for contracts to perform all or part of such projects	
15	and awarding bids pursuant to G.S. 143-129 and G.S. 143- 131, if applicable, to the lowest	
16	responsible bidder or bidder meeting these and other specifications.	
17	(b) <u>The City Council may, on any terms it deems proper, authorize the City Manager or</u>	
18	the City Manager's designee to include minimum minority and/or women's business enterprise	
19 20	participation requirements authorized in subsection (a) of this section in the specifications for	
20 21	contracts to perform all or part of any projects financed by public funds and to award bids to the lowest responsible hidders meeting these and other apacifications."
