A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY BUSINESS TO REQUIRE THAT A

LICENSED DRIVER RELINQUISH HIS OR HER DRIVERS LICENSE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 2A of Chapter 75 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 75-62.1. Drivers license protection.

- (a) A business may not require that a person licensed to operate a motor vehicle surrender or relinquish his or her drivers license to the business for any purpose except as provided by subsection (b) of this section.
- (b) When a copy of a person's drivers license is required to be made by law or contract, a business may request and copy the person's license during the regular business hours of the business and must return the drivers license to the person immediately after making the copy.
 - (c) A violation of this section is a violation of G.S. 75-1.1."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies as to licensed drivers on or after that date.
