Carolina Planning and Economic Development Commission, the Isothermal Planning and Development Commission, the High Country Council of Governments, the Western Piedmont Council of Governments, and the Land of Sky Regional Council. Council, to serve terms of two, three, three, four, and five years, respectively.

One representative appointed by the board of the Blue Ridge National Heritage Area. Area, to serve a two-year term.

Upon the expiration of the terms of the initial Commission members, each position on the Commission shall be appointed by the appointing authorities designated in subdivisions (1) through (6) of this subsection for a four-year term. Members may serve no more than two full terms consecutively. Upon the expiration of their terms, Commission members shall serve until a successor is appointed and qualified. Any vacancy on the Commission shall be filled by the original appointing authority for the remainder of the unexpired term.

(d1) Officers; Terms. Officers; Quorum. – The members of the Commission shall elect a chair, vice-chair, and any other officers they consider necessary and shall determine the length of the term of office, not to exceed two years, of each officer. A majority of the Commission shall constitute a quorum. Each member appointed to the Commission shall be appointed to serve a four year term. Any vacancy on the Commission shall be filled by the original appointing authority for the remainder of the unexpired term. Initial terms commence September 1, 2009.

(e) Salary; Expenses. – Members of the Commission shall receive no salary for their service on the Commission but may receive per diem, subsistence, and travel allowances in accordance with G.S. 120-3.1, 138-5, or 138-6, as appropriate. All expenses shall be paid from funds available to the Commission through the Mountain Area Resources Fund, but no expenses shall be paid if the Mountain Area Resources Fund lacks the necessary funds. ...."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
