A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT REMOVING CERTAIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF COLUMBIA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The property described in Section 1 of S.L. 2007-140 is removed
from the corporate limits of the Town of Columbia.

SECTION 2. This act has no effect upon the validity of any liens of the Town of
Columbia for ad valorem taxes or special assessments outstanding before the effective date of
this act. Such liens may be collected or foreclosed upon after the effective date of this act as
though the property was still within the corporate limits of the Town of Columbia.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
