AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL CONNECTIONS TO WATER SUPPLY LINES FUNDED BY THE CLEAN WATER AND NATURAL GAS CRITICAL NEEDS BOND ACT OF 1998.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Section 1.5(b) of Session Law 1998-132, the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources shall grant a waiver to allow additional connections to a bond-funded water line within an area designated as WS-I or the critical area of any area that has been designated as WS-II, WS-III, or WS-IV by the Environmental Management Commission pursuant to G.S. 143-214.5, provided the design capacity and size of the existing bond-funded line can accommodate the additional connections and the purpose of the additional connection is for either of the following reasons:

- (1) To address an existing threat to public health or water quality.
- (2) To provide water to a habitable structure located on a lot zoned for a single family residence, provided that the lot was platted at the time of the construction of the bond-funded water line. There is no requirement that the habitable structure existed on the lot at the time of the construction of the bond-funded water line.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
