2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE VARIOUS
3 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES AND TO AMEND PROVISIONS FOR VARIOUS
4 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 20-79.4. Special registration plates.

8 (b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates:

9 ...
10 () Charlotte Checkers. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
11 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase
12 "GOCHECKERS.COM" and the logo of the Charlotte Checkers.

13 ...
14 () First Tee. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance
15 with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate may bear a phrase and logo representing youth
16 golf or The First Tee, Inc.

17 ...
18 () Flag of the United States of America. – Issuable to the registered owner of a
19 motor vehicle. The plate shall bear an image of a waving American flag. The
20 Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it
21 receives at least 300 applications for the plate.

23 () I.B.P.O.E.W. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
24 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "The
25 Improved Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the World" and the
26 logo of the Improved Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the World.

28 () Mission Foundation. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
29 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate may bear a phrase and logo
30 selected by Mission Healthcare Foundation, Inc.

- 1 () Morehead Planetarium. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle
2 in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear a phrase and logo
3 selected by the Morehead Planetarium and Science Center.

5 () Municipality Plate. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
6 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear a graphic selected by the
7 municipality represented by the plate and approved by the Division.
8 ...
9 () National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial. – Issuable to the registered
10 owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall
11 bear the phrase "National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial" and the
12 logo of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial.
13 ...
14 () Native Brook Trout. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
15 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Native
16 Brook Trout" with a picture of a brook trout native to North Carolina in the
17 background.
18 ...
19 () NC FIRST Robotics. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
20 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the logo of NC FIRST
21 Robotics and the phrase "NC FIRST Robotics."
22 ...
23 (41) ~~City/County Clerk.~~ NCAMC/NCACC Clerk. – Issuable to a clerk of a city
24 or town municipal governing board or a clerk of a county board of
25 commissioners of a city municipality or county in this State. For a
26 city municipal clerk, the plate shall bear the words "City"NCAMC Clerk"
27 followed by a number representing the city municipal clerk's city or town.
28 The number of a city shall be the order of the city in an alphabetical list of
29 cities that assigns number one to the first city in the list. For a county clerk,
30 the plate shall bear the words "County"NCACC Clerk" followed by a
31 number representing the county clerk's county. The number of a county shall
32 be the order of the county in an alphabetical list of counties that assigns
33 number one to the first county in the list. The Division may not issue the
34 plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300
35 applications for the plate.

37 () NCSC. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance
38 with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "NC Sportsmen's
39 Caucus" and a logo provided by the Congressional Sportsmen's Foundation.

41 () North Carolina Bluegrass Association. – Issuable to the registered owner of
42 a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear a
43 graphic selected by the NC Bluegrass Association.
44 ...
45 () North Carolina Cattlemen's Association. – Issuable to the registered owner
46 of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the
47 seal of the North Carolina Cattlemen's Association.
48 ...
49 () Operation Coming Home. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
50 vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase

- 1 "Operation Coming Home" with a logo designed by Operation Coming
2 Home Foundation, Inc.
3 ...
- 4 () Order of the Long Leaf Pine. – Issuable to a person who has received the
5 award of membership in the Order of the Long Leaf Pine from the Governor.
6 The plate shall bear the phrase "Order of the Long Leaf Pine."
7 ...
- 8 () Pancreatic Cancer Awareness. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
9 vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear a
10 representation of a purple ribbon on the right side of the plate.
11 ...
- 12 ~~(163) Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor~~
13 ~~vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase~~
14 ~~"Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity" and the logo of the Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity,~~
15 ~~Inc.~~
16 ...
- 17 () Professional Engineer. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle
18 in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate may bear a phrase and logo
19 representing the Professional Engineers of North Carolina.
20 ...
- 21 () Red Drum. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
22 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Red Drum"
23 with a picture of a red drum native to North Carolina in the background.
24 ...
- 25 (172) Register of Deeds. – Issuable to a register of deeds. The plate shall bear the
26 words "Register of Deeds" and the letter "R" followed by a number
27 representing the county of the register of deeds. The number of a county
28 shall be the order of the county in an alphabetical list of counties that assigns
29 number one to the first county in the list. A plate issued to a retired register
30 of deeds shall bear the phrase "Register of Deeds, Retired," followed by a
31 number that indicates the county where the register of deeds served and a
32 designation indicating the retired status of the register of deeds.
33 ...
- 34 (175) Retired Legislator. – Issuable to a retired member of the North Carolina
35 General Assembly in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. A person who has
36 served in the North Carolina General Assembly is a retired member for
37 purposes of this subdivision. The plate shall bear "The Great Seal of the
38 State of North Carolina" and, as appropriate, the phrase "Retired Senate
39 Member" or "Retired House Member" followed by a number representing
40 the retired member's district with the letters "RM". If more than one retired
41 member is from the same district, then the number shall be followed by a
42 letter from A through Z. The plates shall be issued in the order applications
43 are received.

- 45 () RiverLink. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
46 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase
47 "RiverLink.org" and a logo representing RiverLink, Inc.
48 ...
- 49 () Sneads Ferry Shrimp Festival. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
50 vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate may bear a phrase and
51 logo representing the Sneads Ferry Shrimp Festival.

 2 () Turtle Rescue Team. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
 3 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear a phrase and logo
 4 selected by the North Carolina State University College of Veterinary
 5 Medicine Turtle Rescue Team.

6 ...
 7 (224) Vietnam Veterans of America. – Issuable to a member of the Vietnam
 8 Veterans of America. The plate shall bear the words "Vietnam Veterans of
 9 America" or "VVA" and the emblem of the VVA. A person may obtain from
 10 the Division a special registration plate under this subdivision for a motor
 11 vehicle or a motorcycle registered in that person's name. The registration
 12 fees and the restrictions on the issuance of a specialized registration plate for
 13 a motorcycle are the same as for any motor vehicle. The Division may not
 14 issue either type of the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives
 15 at least 300 applications for the plate.

 17 () Volunteers in Law Enforcement. – Issuable to a volunteer member of a State
 18 or local law enforcement agency. The plate shall bear the phrase "Volunteers
 19 in Law Enforcement."

 21 () YMCA. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance
 22 with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the logo of the YMCA on the right
 23 side of the plate.

 25 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.4(b)(52) and G.S. 20-79.4(b)(119) are reenacted.
 26 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

27 "(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge a single
 28 Legion of Valor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War registration plate to a
 29 recipient of a Legion of Valor award, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war each
 30 year. The preceding special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle
 31 registration fees in G.S. 20-88, if the registered weight of the vehicle is greater than 6,000
 32 pounds. All other special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration
 33 fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

SECTION 4. G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) of this section among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which

1 is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, which is
 2 established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:
