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1 **SECTION 5.(b)** Members of the Authority shall constitute the governing board of 2 the Authority and may, among other things and from time to time, adopt suitable bylaws, not 3 inconsistent with the provisions of this act. 4 **SECTION 5.(c)** The Authority shall appoint from its members a chair, vice-chair, 5 and such other officers as it may from time to time deem necessary, beneficial, and/or helpful 6 for the orderly conduct of its business. The term of office of the chair and vice-chair is one 7 vear. 8 **SECTION 5.(d)** Each member of the Authority, including the chair, shall have one 9 vote. A majority of the members of the Authority shall constitute a quorum, and, unless 10 otherwise provided in this act, all actions of the Authority shall be determined by a majority 11 vote of all the members, that is six votes in favor. 12 **SECTION 5.(e)** The Authority shall hold meetings at least monthly at such times 13 and places as it from time to time may designate and at such other times on the call of the chair 14 or by five members of the Authority. Notice of meetings shall be provided as required by 15 Article 33C of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes. A monthly meeting of the Authority may 16 be cancelled if it is determined by the chair or six members that such meeting is not required. 17 **SECTION 5.(f)** Members may receive payment or reimbursement for travel, 18 lodging, and meal expenses incurred in transacting business on behalf of the Authority. 19 Members may also receive free parking at any airport owned, leased, subleased, or controlled 20 by the Authority, which members may use for official purposes during the respective member's 21 term of office. 22 **SECTION 5.(g)** The fiscal year of the Authority shall begin on July 1 and end on 23 June 30. On or before May 15 of each year, the Authority shall prepare and adopt a proposed 24 budget for the next ensuing fiscal year and deliver copies of such proposed budget to the 25 Cabarrus, Gaston, and Union County Boards of Commissioners and the Charlotte City Council. 26 SECTION 5.(h) All meetings and closed sessions of the Authority shall be 27 conducted in accordance with Article 33C of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes as it may be amended or in accordance with any successor statute. 28 29 **SECTION 6.(a)** The Authority shall constitute a body, both corporate and politic, 30 and shall have the power and authority to do the following: 31 Adopt and from time to time revise an official seal. (1)32 Maintain an office or offices at such place or places as it may designate (2)33 within Mecklenburg County only. 34 Purchase, acquire, develop, establish, construct, own, control, lease, equip, (3) 35 improve, administer, maintain, operate, and/or regulate airports and/or 36 landing fields for the use of airplanes and other aircraft and all facilities 37 incidental thereto, within the limits of Mecklenburg County; and for any of 38 such purposes, purchase, acquire, own, develop, hold, lease, sublease, and 39 operate real and/or personal property. 40 Purchase real and personal property. then within 90 days of that approval. This transfer includes all property, real or personal,
tangible or intangible, and includes all liabilities.

37 **SECTION 7.(c)** Private property needed by the Authority for any airport, landing 38 field, or facility may be acquired by the Authority by gift, devise, or private purchase. Aviation 39 easements needed by the Authority for any airport, landing field, or facility may likewise be 40 acquired by gift, devise, or private purchase. Unless the power of eminent domain is required 41 by federal law or federal regulation, Chapter 40A of the General Statutes does not apply to the 42 Authority, and it may not exercise the power of eminent domain. If a federal law or federal 43 regulation does require the Authority to have the power to exercise eminent domain, it may 44 only do so for public use for an airport purpose or purposes, and any eminent domain 45 proceeding must be authorized jointly by all of the nine appointing authorities. In no case, 46 however, may the power of eminent domain be used for purposes not necessary for the 47 operation of the airport, and more specifically no property may be acquired by eminent domain 48 for such uses as hotels, motels, restaurants, or industrial parks.

49 **SECTION 7.(d)** Any lands acquired, owned, controlled, or occupied by the 50 Authority shall and/or are hereby declared to be acquired, owned, controlled, and occupied for 51 a public purpose.

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**SECTION 7.(e)** The Authority is not authorized to levy any tax.

2 **SECTION 7.(f)** Any claim by the City of Charlotte on account of acquisition of 3 property by the Authority is extinguished.

4 **SECTION 8.** The Authority shall make annual reports to the Cabarrus, Gaston, 5 Mecklenburg, and Union County Boards of Commissioners and the Charlotte City Council 6 setting forth a summary of its general operations and transactions conducted by it pursuant to 7 this act. The Authority shall be regarded as the corporate instrumentality and agent for 8 Cabarrus, Gaston, Mecklenburg, and Union Counties and the City of Charlotte for the purpose 9 of developing aviation facilities in the Counties of Cabarrus, Gaston, Mecklenburg, and Union, 10 but it shall have no power to pledge the credit of the Counties of Cabarrus, Gaston, 11 Mecklenburg, and Union or the City of Charlotte, or to impose any obligation upon those 12 counties, or the City of Charlotte, except and when such power is expressly granted by statute.

13 **SECTION 9.** All rights, powers, and authority given to the counties and/or 14 municipalities by the statutes of North Carolina, which may now be in effect, or which may be 15 enacted in the future, relating to the development, operation, maintenance, regulation, and/or 16 control of municipal or other governmental airports and the regulations of aircraft are hereby 17 vested in the Authority.

18 **SECTION 10.** The Authority is hereby expressly authorized to make and enter into 19 contracts, leases, subleases, conveyances, and other agreements with any political subdivision, 20 agency, department, or instrumentality of this State, any agency, department, or subdivision of 21 the United States, or any other legal entity or person for the purpose of carrying out the 22 provisions of this act.

23 **SECTION 11.** The powers of the Authority created by this act shall be construed 24 liberally in favor of the Authority. No listing of powers included in this act is intended to be 25 exclusive or restrictive, and the specific mention of, or failure to mention, particular powers in 26 this act shall not be construed as limiting in any way the general powers of the Authority as 27 stated in Section 6(a) of this act. It is the intent of this act to grant the Authority full power and 28 right to exercise all authority necessary for the effective operation and conduct of the 29 Authority. It is further intended that the Authority should have all implied powers necessary or 30 incidental to carrying out the expressed powers and the expressed purposes for which the 31 Authority is created. The fact that this act specifically states that the Authority possesses a 32 certain power does not mean that the Authority must exercise such power unless this act 33 specifically so requires.

34 **SECTION 12.** G.S. 66-58(a) shall not apply to the Charlotte Regional Airport 35 Authority or a lessee or sublessee of the Charlotte Regional Airport Authority.

36 **SECTION 13.** If any provision of this act or its application is held invalid, the 37 invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this act that can be given effect 38 without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are 39 severable.

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**SECTION 14.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
